

**Top 8 Things to Remember for a Girls Inc. Summer!**

1. Remember to bring your Early Bird money if you plan to drop your girl off between 6:30am-9:45am in the mornings.
2. Money for lunch and snacks - you may also send food items from home.
3. No electronics or toys from home will be allowed at Girls Inc. during the summer.
4. You're welcome to send money for the pool. Concessions at the pool vary in price.
5. Our center closes at 12:00 on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, so girls must be picked up or dropped off by that time in order to go to the movies and pool.
6. No one can pick up your girl unless they are listed under the "pick up information" on her emergency card or you give permission to Girls Inc. in a phone call.
7. Staff emails will only be answered during business hours. If you need to reach someone— please call and leave a voice message.
8. While flip flops are fun, they may not be the best for a fun filled day at Girls Inc.! Please consider sending tennis shoes - especially on movie and pool day!



**The Big 5 Summer Swimming Rules**

1. Items needed on swim day include: swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, extra clothing, money for snacks, and a bag to carry items.
2. Girls must leave and return with Girls Inc.
3. Bring only what you can carry. Girls are responsible for carrying their own belongings.
4. To go to the deep end, members must pass our swimming test.
5. Girls will NOT be allowed to change out of their bathing suit at the pool when leaving. If girls want to change, they must wait until they return to Girls Inc.


